DMA acceptance of Fusiotherm plastic pipes

To whom it may concern.

This is to confirm that the Danish Maritime Authority (Søfartsstyrelsen) can accept the use of "Fusiotherm" plastic pipes of the types mentioned in "Type Approval Certificate" No. 86 069 – 96 HH, from "Germanischer Lloyd"; for the following purposes in ships (as defined in IMO Resolution A.753(18) Annex 4):


Piping systems 19 (Seawater¹ non-essential systems) and 22 (freshwater non-essential systems), in Location I (Cofferdams, void spaces, pipe tunnels and ducts).

The pipes shall be installed in compliance with IMO Resolution A.753(18) paragraph 4.

This acceptance is only valid together with the valid type approval certificate mentioned above.

¹ Where non metallic piping is used, remotely controlled valves to be provided at ship's side (valve is to be controlled from outside space).
